13	WHEREAS, the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic has been a global public
14	health concern since the end of 2019 when it was first discovered abroad and has been
15	a severe crisis in the United States since February 2020; and

17	WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the County Executive declared a local public
18	health emergency due to COVID-19; and

20	WHEREAS, from the time the County Executive issued the Emergency
21	Proclamation through the end of 2021, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (the
22	board) has met 33 times virtually due to health safety concerns to conduct County
23	business; and

25	WHEREAS, File No. 20-570, adopted July 23, 2020, created Section 1.01(d) of
26	the Milwaukee County General Ordinances, supported by legal opinions on Open
27	Meetings, which provides:

29	"The county board may convene and meet to conduct business remotely via
30	telephone conference, video conference or other electronic communication
31	provided that the meeting is live-streamed, televised live or otherwise broadcast
32	live to the public."

36	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has implemented numerous mitigation measures intended to slow the spread of COVID-19 and protect employees, service users, and the

40	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County's current mitigation efforts include requiring all
41	visitors and employees to wear facial coverings in county facilities, social distance
42	markings, regular cleaning of highly trafficked areas, encouraging employees to work
43	remotely when possible, and more; and

 WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reports that positive COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations are down 53.1 percent nationally since COVID-19 peaked January 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the declining positive COVID-19 cases provides renewed hope that in-person or hybrid meetings can be held safely and efficiently in conformance with public health guidelines and county policy; and

WHEREAS, the CDC guidance surrounding in-person gatherings includes modifying layouts and installation of barriers for social distancing, improving ventilation, increased cleaning, mask wearing, and more; and

WHEREAS, to hold in-person or hybrid meetings safely and efficiently, County Board meeting rooms need to be reconfigured to comply with CDC recommendations, County policies, and technology upgrades to effectively allow participants remote access to the meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of March 17, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 22-436 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Office of Strategy, Budget and Performance and the Office of the Comptroller is authorized to process an appropriation transfer of \$150,000 from Org. Unit 1940-1945 – Appropriation for Contingencies to create a new Capital Improvement project County Board Meeting Room Health Safety and Public Access to provide funding and project management services for in-person or hybrid meetings per Milwaukee County General Ordinance Section 1.01(d) and to comply with CDC and County policy recommendations and to facilitate accessibility during and after the Coronavirus pandemic; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Office of Strategy, Budget and Performance is requested to explore the availability and eligibility of COVID-19 Mitigation funds, or another non-tax levy source of funding, to reduce the amount outlined in the previous clause or to supplement project funding if it is determined later that additional funds are required for improvements for physical meeting access and the safety of the public, County staff, and elected representatives.
