WHEREAS, Joseph Calderaro, Medical Doctor, meets the training requirements and qualifications set forth by the Medical Examiner; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Adopted Budget includes monies for the Forensic Pathology Fellowship Program; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of March 17, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 22-460 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

 BE IT RESOLVED, the Office of the Medical Examiner is authorized to enter into an Agreement with the Medical College of Wisconsin Affiliated Hospitals, for a period of 12-months (July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023), for a cost of \$49,000 in 2022, and \$49,000 in 2023, a copy of which has been attached to and made a part of this file; and

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, the aforementioned Agreement shall only be executed after review and approval by Corporation Counsel, Office of Corporation Counsel, Director, Risk Management Division, Department of Administrative Services, and the Milwaukee County Comptroller, Office of the Comptroller.
