9 10 11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) was signed into law by President Joseph Biden on March 11, 2021, in efforts to provide support to individuals, families and businesses impacted by the Coronavirus Disease pandemic; and
14 15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) will directly receive \$183 million in ARPA funding through the Federal government's State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund; and
18 19 20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, on June 24, 2021, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) approved a resolution to establish the ARPA Task Force, which will use a public process to make non-binding recommendations for ARPA allocations to the County Board; and
23 24 25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, in Adopted File No. 21-389, the County committed to becoming carbon neutral by 2050, and requested the Director, Office of Sustainability, Department of Administrative Services, to develop and administer a strategic plan to achieve carbon neutrality in County facilities and operations by 2050; and
29 30 31	WHEREAS, the ARPA Task Force recommended an allocation of \$2,171,566 in ARPA funding for the Climate Action Plan and Lighting Upgrades project at its meeting of March 10, 2022; and
 32 33 34 35 36 37 	WHEREAS, the requested \$2,171,566 in ARPA funding will be used to advance the County's carbon neutrality initiative by: 1) launching a lighting upgrades program (the Program) in County buildings; and 2) developing a "Climate Action 2050 Plan" (the Plan) for County operations; and
38 39 40 41	WHEREAS, the Program will reduce County operating costs and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by approximately \$258,664, and 611 metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent per year, respectively; and
41 42 43 44 45 46	WHEREAS, the Program will actively seek participation by women, people of color, and residents of Qualified Census Tracts to help dismantle barriers to careers in the trades, which offer good wages but currently lack racial/ethnic and gender diversity; and

- WHEREAS, the Plan will identify GHG emission mitigation and climate
 adaptation strategies that provide financial, equity, and health co-benefits for
 communities of color and other vulnerable populations; and
- 51 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of March 17, 2022,
- recommended adoption of File No. 22-389 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,
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BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance, and the Office of the Comptroller, to create a new Capital Improvement Project named Climate Action Plan and Lighting Upgrades, and to process an administrative appropriation transfer of \$2,171,566 from Milwaukee County's allocated American Rescue Plan Act funding, to establish budget authority for the project.

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
