REQUEST

Authorization to Apply for Federal 5339(b) Grants for Buses & Bus Facilities Competitive Program and 5339(c) Low or No Emissions Grant Program.

POLICY

Per section 56.06 of the Milwaukee County General Ordinances, authorization is required from the appropriate county board standing committee prior to applying for discretionary federal or state grants that require a local match.

BACKGROUND

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) announced on March 7, 2022, the opportunity to apply for \$372 million in competitive grants under the FY 2022 Section 5339(b) Grants for Buses and Bus Facilities Competitive Program and \$1.1 billion under the FY 2022 5339(c) Low or No Emission Grant Program. As required by Federal public transportation law, 5339(b) funds will be awarded competitively to assist in the financing of buses and bus facilities capital projects, while 5339(c) funds support the transition of the nation's transit fleet to the lowest polluting and most energy efficient transit vehicles. Grant awards require a minimum 20% local match and applications are due May 31, 2022.

The Milwaukee County Department of Transportation presently intends to request funding for 30 clean diesel buses under the 5339(b) program at an estimated per-unit cost of \$600,000 and funding for ten battery electric buses and two charging units at an estimated per-unit cost of \$1,500,000 under 5339(c). The grant amounts to be requested are \$14,400,000 under each of these programs. If approval to apply is granted, and if an award is received, the funding will be used in a future capital budget request depending on the specific needs of the Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) at that time.

RECOMMENDATION

The Director of the Milwaukee County Department of Transportation recommends authorization to submit requests to the 5339(b) competitive buses and bus facilities program and the 5339(c)

low-no program for \$14.4 million each for the purchase of up to 30 clean diesel and up to ten battery electric buses (and two chargers).

FISCAL EFFECT

The direct fiscal impact is dependent on the grant amount (if any) that is ultimately awarded. In the event of a full award, the local share requested in the applicable county capital budget would \$3,600,000 for each award. The total requested MCTS capital amounts will not be impacted by this submission because MCTS' needs are independent of whether an award is received.
