REQUEST

Courts is requesting to create 7.0 FTE Deputy Court Clerks and 5.0 FTE Specialist Clerical Cts- with State ARPA funding to expand Court operations and reduce the backlog.

BACKGROUND

In March of 2020, jury trials and statutory speedy trial rights were suspended due to the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. This led to a growing backlog of cases.

Court stakeholders, supported by County Executive David Crowley's recovery team, acted early and aggressively to restart jury trials and in person proceedings as quickly and safely as possible. The county expended Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) dollars to upgrade technology in the courtroom and provide necessary PPE to keep litigants, jurors, staff, and others safe as the courts opened, and remained open, even when the virus was at its worst. In addition, the Office of State Courts, provided videoconferencing resources to help the courts shift to remote proceedings where appropriate.

As of January, Milwaukee County faced a backlog of approximately 2,600 misdemeanors, 1,700 felonies, and 925 criminal traffic cases. Milwaukee County anticipates it will take between 2 and 3 years to clear the identified backlog and resume resolving cases within the state and national time standard. Milwaukee County was awarded ARPA funds to expand court operations to reduce the backlog. To accomplish that, the proposal is to add: 3 judges to the felony division, 1 judge to the misdemeanor division, and 1 judge to the domestic violence courts. To support this expansion by the

judiciary, additional support staff are needed and funded by State ARPA grant received by Milwaukee County Courts.

FISCAL EFFECT

The cost for the positions in 2022 is \$369,714, assuming a hire date of June 1, 2022. The total 2023 annual salary and social security cost of the twelve requested position is \$633,796. All position costs will be fully funded by the State ARPA grant.
