- A. The Chief Deputy, Office of the Sheriff, requests permission to apply and accept funding from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Mental Health and Wellness Act (LEMHWA) program. LEMHWA funds are used to improve the delivery of and access to mental health and wellness services for law enforcement officers through the implementation of peer support, training, family resources, suicide prevention, and other promising practices for wellness programs.
- B. The total estimated grant amount is at \$175,000 for a period of twenty-four months. In the current year the estimated amount is \$29,167 and in the subsequent years it will be \$145,833. The period of performance start date is 9/1/22 12.00 A.M.
- C. \$29,167 is not in the 2022 adopted budget and an appropriate fund transfer will be requested. \$87,500 will be included in the 2023 and \$58,333 will be requested in 2024 requested budgets.
- D. Assumption includes that entire request by the department is awarded through the LEMHWA program. There is no impact on tax levy and there is no requirement for cost sharing or a local match for this grant.
