n s	• Wisconsin family caregivers need help. Family caregivers are the primary
	<ul> <li>providers of long-term carecare that often goes beyond what they can do when they also have jobs or live far away, doing things like providing:         <ul> <li>direct care</li> <li>scheduling medical and therapy appointments</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	transportation
	<ul> <li>medication management applications</li> </ul>
	• There are not enough providers to hire for assistance.
Why Does it Matter?	***************************************
	<ul> <li>Many family caregivers face financial burdens because they:</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>have to leave their jobs or reduce work hours;</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>have no paid leave benefits; and</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>spend, on average, \$7,000 out-of-pocket annually on expenses related to their caregiving role, and even more when caregiving from a distance.</li> </ul>
	• Family caregivers need breaks. Limited respite funding and lack of providers is making it difficult for caregivers to receive a break.
	• Continual stress has a negative effect on the physical and mental health of both family caregivers and the people they care for.
	<ul> <li>Aging family caregivers may need supports and services themselves to remain at home.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>It is difficult for those needing care who lack family caregivers or paid providers to stay in their own homes and communities.</li> </ul>
