- A. A \$2.75 per hour premium pay increase is requested for Adult Protective Services (APS) staff who are in compliance with the Vaccine Order for Milwaukee County.
- B. The 2022 estimated cost of the retroactive pay increase, reflecting salary and social security, is \$25,009 based on a January 1, 2022 effective start date through March 31, 2022 for 17 APS staff.
- C. This cost is supported out of funding appropriated under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act of 2021. The State of Wisconsin received a total award of \$1.15 million to be distributed to county APS lead agencies. Milwaukee County DHHS received an allocation of \$71,862.
- D. No other assumptions have been made.
