# CDC - COVID-19 Framework

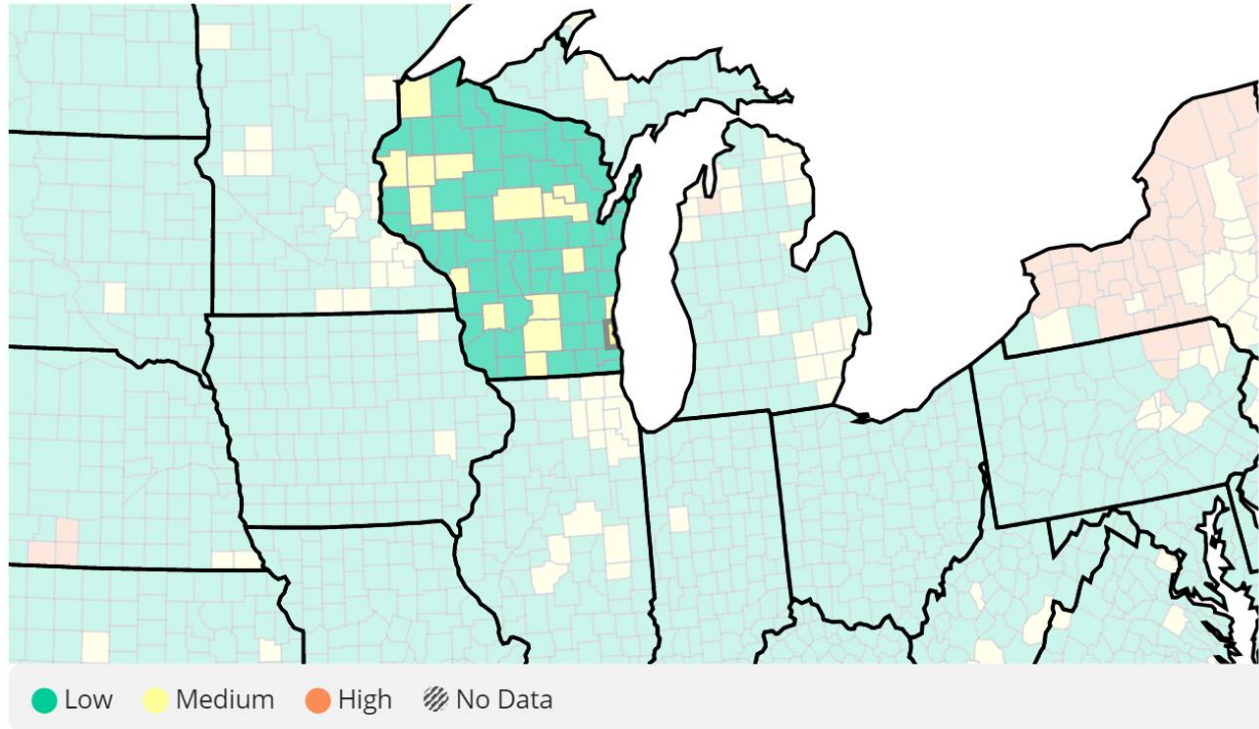
COVID-19 Community Levels – Use the Highest Level that Applies to Your Community				
New COVID-19 Cases Per 100,000 people in the past 7 days	Indicators	Low	Medium	High
Fewer than 200	New COVID-19 admissions per 100,000 population (7-day total)	<10.0	10.0-19.9	≥20.0
	Percent of staffed inpatient beds occupied by COVID-19 patients (7-day average)	<10.0%	10.0-14.9%	≥15.0%
200 or more	New COVID-19 admissions per 100,000 population (7-day total)	NA	<10.0	≥10.0
	Percent of staffed inpatient beds occupied by COVID-19 patients (7-day average)	NA	<10.0%	≥10.0%

- Released in February 2022
- Comprised of three measures
- Updated weekly
- Along with Dr. Weston’s advisement, forms the basis for the County’s internal COVID mitigation approaches

COVID-19 Community Levels in Milwaukee County, Wisconsin

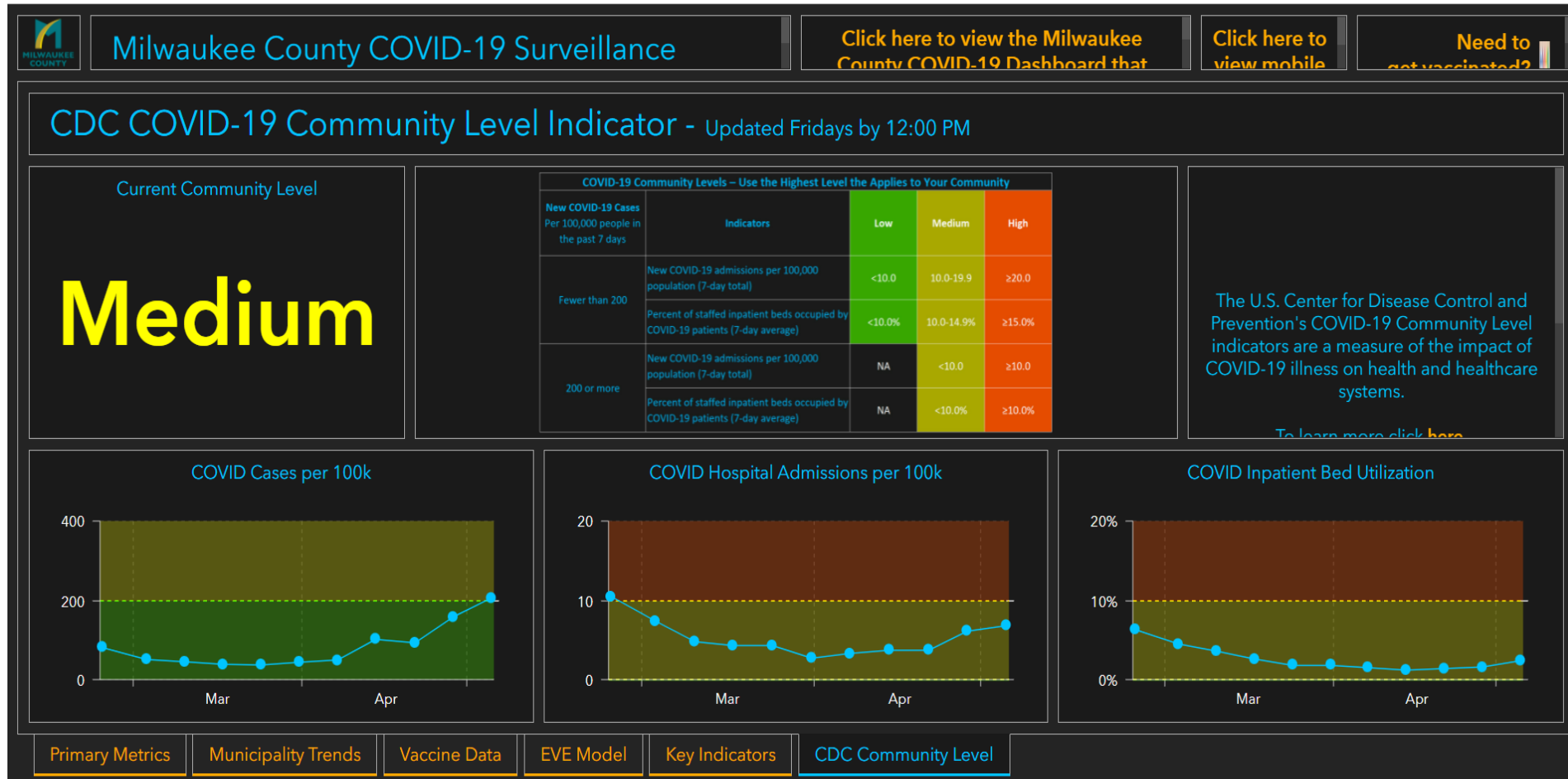

- New Admissions Rate = 6.8
- Hospital Capacity = 2.4%
- Case Rate = 205.87
- Milwaukee County is currently classified as “medium”

# Recent Changes

- Masking at the Courthouse Complex and the Vel Philips Youth and Family Justice Center
  - All visitors
  - Employees interacting with visitors or when in public areas
- Distinction between high-risk facilities, facilities serving mostly vulnerable populations and facilities providing essential services

## Former COVID-19 Governance Documents

Former COVID-19 Governance Document	Status
Social Distancing Admin Order	No longer needed, social distancing guidelines are detailed in the facility capacity procedure
Uses and Priority of Face Masks and Respirators	Reference document that provided additional details on various mask types. Masking guidelines are detail in the masking procedure
Telework Administrative Order	This administrative order has expired, and the County's Telework procedures are detailed in the Telework AMOP
State and County emergency proclamations	Expired, and removed from internal and external websites
