The Office of Strategy, Budget and Performance and the Department of Health and Human Services request \$1.1 million in ARPA funding to support the Milwaukee Market Match, by recommending adoption of the following:

## A REVISED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 was signed into law by President Biden on March 11, 2021, in efforts to support individuals, families, businesses, and governments impacted by the Coronavirus Disease pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) will receive \$183.7 million in ARPA funding, through the ARPA State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors adopted File No. 21-555: "A resolution to create a Task Force (ARPA Task Force) to review and recommend funding allocations to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for monies received by the County in the Federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021"; and

WHEREAS, of the County's \$183.7 million of ARPA aid, approximately \$36,739,238, has been recommended by the ARPA Task Force for Community Support, to generate projects that respond to economic harms to workers, families, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector in the County; and

WHEREAS, in March of 2022, the Community Support Subgroup – Other Social Determinants of Health, recommended the Milwaukee Market Match (MMM) Project receive \$1.1 million in Community Support, based on criteria set forth by the ARPA Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the MMM Project will increase the purchase and consumption of locally grown fruits and vegetables by accepting Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program/Electronic Benefits Transfer benefits at County Farmer's Markets; and

WHEREAS, by providing incentives at the point of purchase, Wisconsin grown produce is made more affordable by doubling the value of the customer's transaction; and

WHEREAS, the MMM Project promotes equitable economic investment by increasing the income of small family produce farmers, many of whom are County residents; and

 43 WHEREAS, the \$1.1 million budget over three years (2022-2024) reflects direct 44 nutrition incentive coupons and program oversight provided by Fondy Food Center, and 45 includes \$100,000 in administrative support from the Department of Health and Human 46 Services; and 47 48 WHEREAS, the ARPA Task Force recommended the MMM Project for funding 49 on April 14, 2022 (vote 6-0); and 50 51 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of May 19, 2022. 52 recommended adoption of File No. 22-597 (vote 7-0); now, therefore, 53 54 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) 55 authorizes the Milwaukee Market Match (MMM) Project supported by American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) revenue in the amount of \$1,100,000 to the Department of Health and 56 57 Human Services (DHHS); and 58 59 60 61 62

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes DHHS to develop and administer the MMM Project, and enter into a Purchase of Service Contract with Fondy Food Center for a total amount up to \$1,000,000 for 2022 through 2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance, and the Office of the Comptroller, to process an administrative appropriation transfer in the amount of \$316,643, to direct funds to DHHS for the MMM Project starting July 1, 2022, until December, 2022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes the MMM Project to continue at an estimated full-year cost of \$366,678 in 2023, and \$416,679 in 2024, with ARPA monies that shall be allocated in 2023 and 2024 to DHHS for this program.

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
