Requesting recommendation of the Early Childhood & Family Support project within the Community Support Expenditure Category for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding consideration.

POLICY

Milwaukee County Board file 21-555: "A resolution to create a Task Force to review and recommend funding allocations to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for monies received by the County in the Federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021"

BACKGROUND

Milwaukee County will directly receive \$183 million between 2021-24 in federal ARPA aid. Approximately \$37 million has been allotted for Community Support projects.

The Community Support Service Area subgroup was established to generate project-level allocation recommendations to respond to economic harms to workers, families, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector in Milwaukee County.

The Other Social Determinants of Health subgroup was formed with subject matter experts following the Community Support Service Area Subgroup Charter. Membership includes the following individuals:
