 - Declare a preference against vast swaths of land in Milwaukee County being used for parking lots and direct the conversation toward any additional public subsidy to the Southeast Wisconsin Professional Baseball Park District's professional baseball stadium
 - Call for the District to collaborate with the City of Milwaukee and Village of West Milwaukee to redevelop lands in their respective municipalities in collaboration with the District, and the District's tenant; and study tax incremental financing as a development mechanism
 - Encourage a large Village of West Milwaukee landholder, Komatsu, to cooperate
 - Request the Wisconsin Department of Transportation study dismantlement of the Stadium Freeway (State Trunk Highway (STH) 175) south of Interstate 94 in addition to its study of STH 175 from West Wisconsin Avenue northward
- B. This resolution does not obligate any funds. Staff time will be required to communicate the contents of this resolution to the Wisconsin Governor, State lawmakers, WisDOT, City of Milwaukee, Village of West Milwaukee, Southeast Wisconsin Professional Baseball Park District, Komatsu Mining Corporation, and Komatsu America Corporation.
- C. This resolution has no budgetary impact.
