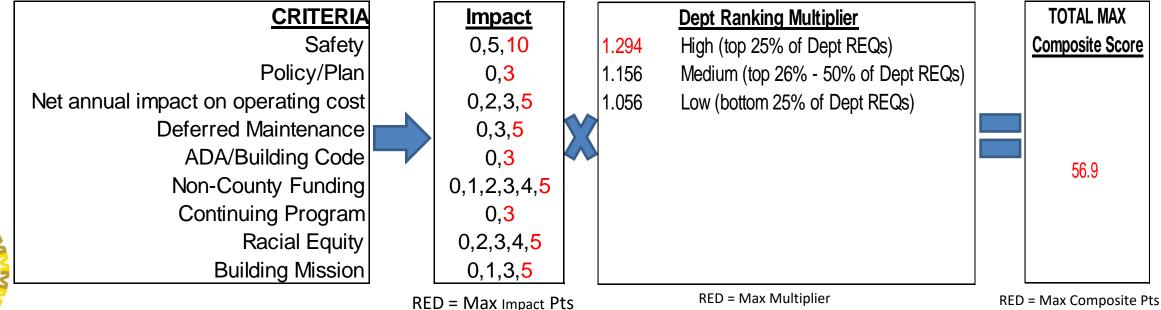

Mandated

Projects related to fed/state/local/court ordered requirements



Contractual

Projects by which the County has been obligated to provide

Continuing/Ongoing

Projects with previously adopted appropriations (<u>construction must be based on completed design</u>)

Capital Project Scoring Criteria

Design First Approach

DEFINITION-

For most projects, the design appropriations are made in one year, and then construction appropriation(s) in a subsequent year (upon completion of design).

- Primarily AE managed projects
- Potential future application to IMSD managed technology projects
- oPotential future application to Transportation Services managed projects (NOTE: Transportation Services follow a design first approach for a number of projects)



REASONING-

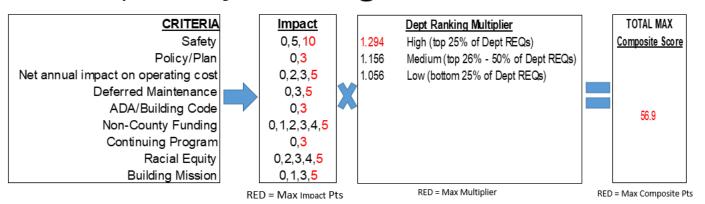
Project and construction cost estimate efficiency:

- Completed design = construction/implementation
