 - A. The Department of Human Resources has worked with the Office of Strategy, Budget and Performance as well as the Administration in developing a proposal to provide for an additional 2% general increase for Milwaukee County Employees effective August 21, 2022.
 - B. The approximate cost of a 2% increase effective in pay period 18 would be \$1.7 million for the balance of 2022 and the annualized resulting impact would be approximately \$4.9 million
 - C. There is a \$2.5M midyear tax levy allocation (\$5M annualized) in the 2022 Budget that was set aside for midyear compensation adjustments based on recommendations resulting from the Compensation Transformation Project.
 - D. FICA impacts of 7.65% are included in the costs.
