

ARPA Community Support Project Pipeline

On September 2, 2021, the ARPA Task Force approved ARPA Expenditure Categories and a process for reviewing and recommending ARPA funding allocations. This dashboard displays project activities related to Milwaukee County's Community Support expenditure category project pipeline.

The Community Support category allows Milwaukee County to respond to economic harms to workers, families, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector. Projects advance Milwaukee County strategic objectives 2A) Determine what, where and how services are delivered based on the resolution of health disparities; 3A) invest upstream to address the root causes of health disparities; and 3C) dismantle barriers to achieving diverse and inclusive communities.


Revenue Loss Recovery Dashboard

	This allocation will support ongoing emergency needs related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Examples include COVID-19 communications, testing of employees, vaccine administration costs, and other expenses needed for the safety of employees and the public.	\$2,500,000

- The COVID-19 Mitigation Subgroup continues to meet on a regular basis to review projects and evaluate the most efficient way to approve project submissions.
- As of June 2, 2022, the subgroup has reviewed 18 requests for COVID-19 mitigation funds and approved \$1,069,718 in expenses.

Community Engagement & Strategic Partnerships	Build a sustainable model for equitable community engagement that centers on community health and resilience, and that builds leadership, organizational, and advocacy capacity of County residents and vulnerable communities to be full and equal partners in determining and implementing strategies for COVID response and recovery.	\$2,087,500

- The Office of Strategy, Budget, & Performance will release a Request for Proposal (RFP) to meet the U.S. Department of the Treasury evaluation requirements.
- The Office of Equity will implement a sustainable model for equitable community engagement.
- The Office of Strategy, Budget & Performance will submit the Quarterly State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Report & Annual Recovery Plan Performance Report by July 31, 2022.
- The subgroup will continue to ensure project management systems and resources are in place.
