9 10 11 12	WHEREAS, the Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 was signed into law by President Biden on March 11, 2021, in efforts to support individuals, families, businesses, and governments impacted by the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic; and
13 14 15 16	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) will receive \$183.7 million in ARPA funding, through the ARPA State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund; and
17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors adopted File No. 21-555: "A resolution to create a Task Force (ARPA Task Force) to review and recommend funding allocations to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for monies received by the County in the Federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021;" and
21 22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, of the County's \$183.7 million of ARPA aid, approximately \$36,739,238 has been recommended by the ARPA Task Force for Community Support, to coordinate use of ARPA funds for programmatic and fiscal accountability, reporting, and alignment with other funding; and
26 27 28 29 30	WHEREAS, in May of 2022, the Community Support Subgroup – other Social Determinants of Health, recommended the Beach Ambassador Project (the Project) receive \$128,500 in Community Support based on criteria set forth by the ARPA Task Force; and
31 32 33 34 35 36 37	WHEREAS, the Project was developed in 2021 by Milwaukee community partners (Milwaukee Water Commons, Wisconsin Sea Grant, Milwaukee Community Sailing Center, Milwaukee Riverkeeper, and Coastline Services) as a response to water safety concerns at Lake Michigan beaches, such as increased beach use during the COVID-19 pandemic, inadequate signage, a lifeguard shortage, and racial inequities related to swimming, water safety, and increased drownings; and
38 39 40 41	WHEREAS, safety concerns along Lake Michigan beaches persist in 2022, including the shortage of lifeguards and inequities in swim ability, both of which are expected to continue for years to come; and
42 43 44 45 46	WHEREAS, the Milwaukee community partners who have organized the Project have supplemented the efforts of County staff, and served a great need in the community that otherwise could not be provided by County staff; and

- WHEREAS, the ARPA Task Force recommended the Project for funding on 47 June 9, 2022; and 48 49 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of July 21, 2022, 50 recommended adoption of File No. 22-782 (vote 7-0); now, therefore, 51 52 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) 53 authorizes the Beach Ambassador Project (the Project) supported by American Rescue 54 Plan Act (ARPA) revenue, in the amount of \$128,500 to the Department of Parks, 55 Recreation, and Culture (DPRC); and 56 57 58 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes the DPRC to develop and administer the Project, and enter into a multi-year service agreement with 59 the Milwaukee Water Commons for a total amount up to \$128,500; and 60 61 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes the Office of 62 Strategy, Budget, and Performance (OSBP), and the Office of the Comptroller 63 (Comptroller) to process an administrative appropriation transfer of \$128,500 to direct 64 funds to the DPRC for the Project; and 65 66 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board authorizes the administrating 67 department, the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), the Office of Corporation 68 Counsel, Risk Management Division, DAS, Community Business Development 69 Partners, DAS, Comptroller, OSBP, and the Office of the County Executive, to prepare, 70 review, approve, and execute all contracts and other documents, and take all actions as 71 required for the purpose of administering the above-referenced programs funded by the 72 ARPA grant allocation framework. 73 74 75 76 77 78 srb 07/21/2022
