WHEREAS, Gregg Miliacca will be responsible for managing existing ICS communication contracts at the Wisconsin Department of Corrections, and the County; and

WHEREAS, onboarding Gregg Miliacca would be an asset to ICS, and thus to the County; and

WHEREAS, the HOC believes the best solution is for Gregg Miliacca to be allowed to perform work for the County as a contractor for ICS; and
