Stat. § 8 940.04, which bans abortion at any stage of pregnancy without exception for rape, 9 10 incest, or health of the patient, should be repealed to allow legal access to abortion care 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the 1973 U.S. Supreme Court ruling in Roe v. Wade made access to 14 safe and legal abortion a constitutional right in the United States; and WHEREAS, in a nearly unprecedented taking of a settled right in the United 15 States, the U.S. Supreme Court issued a ruling on June 24, 2022, in *Dobbs v. Jackson* 16 Women's Health Organization which overturned Roe v. Wade allowing states to ban 17 abortion: and 18 19 WHEREAS, a Marquette University poll taken in June of 2022 indicated that 59 percent of Wisconsin residents support access to abortion care in all or almost all 20 21 cases; and 22 WHEREAS, Wisconsin has a 173-year-old criminal abortion law still in its 23 statutes which effectively bans all abortions in the state by making it a felony to perform 24 an abortion with no exceptions for rape, incest, or the health of the pregnant person; 25 and 26 WHEREAS, persons seeking abortion care will need to travel from Wisconsin to 27 a state that does not restrict women from making their own healthcare choices and 28 allows access to safe and legal abortions; and 29 WHEREAS, denying residents access to abortion care has a disproportionate impact on Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC), low-income communities, 30 people with disabilities, and members of the LGBTQ+ community who are likely to have 31 32 barriers to transportation and related expenses; and 33 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County adopted Chapter 108 of the Code of General 34 Ordinances – Achieving Racial Equity and Health in April 2019 to demonstrate its unwavering commitment to reducing racial and health inequities; and 35 36 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County residents should have the opportunity to voice 37 their opinion on whether Wis. Stat. § 940.04, which bans abortion at any stage of pregnancy without exception for rape, incest, or health of the patient, should be 38 39 repealed to allow legal access to abortion care; and

41 WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and General 42 Services, at its meeting of July 15, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 22-884 43 (vote 3-2); and 44 45 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of July 21, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 22-884 (vote 4-3); now, therefore, 46 47 48 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby affirms its support to protect abortion care as the right to choose and the residents of 49 50 Milwaukee County and the State of Wisconsin should have access to this healthcare 51 service in their own community; and 52 53 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the County Board of Supervisors of Milwaukee 54 County, Wisconsin, as follows: 55 56 Section 1. Referendum Election. The County Clerk is hereby directed to call an 57 advisory referendum election to be held in the County at the regularly scheduled election to be held November 8, 2022, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified 58 59 electors of the county the proposition of whether the State of Wisconsin should repeal Wisconsin Statute § 940.04, which bans abortion at any stage of pregnancy without 60 exception for rape, incest, or health of the patient, to allow legal access to abortion care. 61 The referendum shall be held, noticed, and conducted following the procedures set forth 62 63 in Section 59.52 (25) of the Wisconsin Statutes. 64 Section 2. Official Referendum Ballot Form. The ballot to be used at the referendum election shall be prepared in accordance with the provisions of Sections 65 5.64 (2) and 7.08 (1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes. The ballot shall be substantially in 66 67 the form attached hereto as Exhibit A. 68 ; and 69 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of Strategy, Budget and Performance and the Office of the 70 71 Comptroller to process an appropriation transfer of \$18,000 from Org. Unit 1800-1945 – 72 Appropriation for Contingencies to appropriate accounts in Org. Unit 3270 – County 73 Clerk Election Commission Division to offset the cost of the referendum in 2022. 74 75 76 07/21/2022
