Life Navigators, Family Support for Aging and Persons with Developmental Disabilities

Life Navigators provides in-home and community based services to individuals with intellectual and related disabilities and their aging caregivers. Life Navigators works with individuals and families throughout the county. Consumers come from referrals from MCDA, DSD and from information, education and outreach services. The Family Support program provides services to aging adults with intellectual and related disabilities and their aging caregivers. The program is designed to ensure safe, healthy lives in our community through futures planning services, crisis intervention, connection to services and support.

Life Navigators has served individuals throughout the Covid-19 Pandemic through a combination of in-person, phone and virtual appointments and meetings.

• The first six months of 2022 have been very active in the program. Several new families have reached out for individualized futures planning services as well as connections to services in the community for themselves and their loved ones. The program has also seen a large increase in individuals wanting to be active in their community and participate in events that enhance their quality of life and connection to services.

 One of the largest challenges of 2022 so far has been the lack of caregivers and safe, appropriate placements for individuals with developmental disabilities. Families are strained by the role of caregiving with little to no respite due to the current caregiver shortage.

 Life Navigators has increased staffing capacity to the program in order to meet the growing need. In addition, expanded outreach has been focusing efforts to reach all communities in the county to ensure families and individuals are aware of the services offered by this program and are able to access them.
