24	WHEREAS, an "inclusive restroom" is one available for use by any person(s) and
25 26	is not designated for use by persons of any specific sex and/or gender; and
27	WHEREAS, "inclusive restroom signage" marks a restroom as one which does
28	not indicate any specific sex and/or gender, must include the word "restroom" in braille,
29	may include icons indicating the presence of a toilet, sink, baby changing facility, and if
30	the restroom is universally accessible; and

32	WHEREAS, in 2019, the City of Milwaukee in its File No. 191168 passed a
33	resolution "relating to the establishment of a gender-inclusive restroom policy for City
34	buildings."; and
35 26	WHEREAS, howing inclusive restrooms with inclusive signage is importained for
36 37	WHEREAS, having inclusive restrooms with inclusive signage is imperative for Milwaukee County to achieve health equity; and
38	Milwaukee County to achieve health equity, and
