- A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to sign a 2023 Social Services and Community Programs contract with the State Department of Health Services (DHS). Approval will allow Milwaukee County to receive State revenue for county services for persons with disabilities and their families, older adults as well as those in need of community support and prevention services as mandated by State and/or Federal law.
- B. The state's Social Services and Community Programs contract includes various separate revenues used to fund DHHS. Approval to sign the 2023 contract will allow Milwaukee County to receive funds.
- C. The actual 2023 "Community Aids" contract for DHHS provides an allocation totaling \$17,127,720; this amount is \$32,471 more than the amount contained in the 2023 DHHS Budget. Similar to previous years, the 2023 contract for Social Services and Community Programs requires a match amount of \$3,565,149 which is included in the 2023 Budget.
- D. The fiscal information was taken from the DHS 2023 contract notification. No further assumptions are made.
