- A. The Director, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), is requesting approval to execute affordable housing development contracts with Milwaukee Habitat for Humanity, Inc. and Emem Group, LLC. as well as establish capital project WS014801 NIF Affordable Housing Development.
- B. The State of Wisconsin awarded \$6 million in Neighborhood Investment Funds (NIF) to DHHS-Housing Services for this project. The contracts being recommended as a result of a Request for Proposals (RFP) process include \$4.2 million to Milwaukee Habitat for Humanity, Inc. and \$1.8 million to Emem Group, LLC for the period of January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023. The resolution also authorizes the establishment of a budget for capital project WS014801 for a total of \$6 million in expenditures and offsetting revenue.
- C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request.
