- A. DHHS is requesting the creation of five Community Intervention Specialist positions and one Administrative Assistant position in Housing Services.
- B. The total annual increased cost for this action is between \$308,663 and \$364,100 (as of pay period 4) in salary and social security depending upon placement in the range. The cost is supported by a newly awarded U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) HOME Investment Partnerships American Rescue Plan Program (HOME-ARP) grant of \$4,499,862 effective through September 30, 2030 and a permanent Emergency Solutions Grant of \$146,016.
- C. The total fiscal impact for the remainder of 2022 is \$0 since the position will not be filled until early 2023.
- D. The fiscal note assumes that once the HUD ARP grant sunsets in 2030, these positions will be abolished or another source of funding will be identified. No further assumptions or interpretations were made.
