# Background & Recommendation Process



#### Background

On December 15, 2021, the Milwaukee County Board approved Resolution 21-1127 which authorized Corporation Counsel to enter into a Settlement Agreement resulting in the following:

- Milwaukee County will receive \$56.6 million.
- Any unused funds that remain at the end of the year will be carried over to the new year.

#### **Assessment of Proposals**

- Proposals addressed one of the seven funding objectives.
- Proposals aligned with one of the four remediation categories (treatment, harm reduction, prevention, other strategies).
- Proposals were scored based on a predetermined rubric of criteria and ranked by average score for priority.
- An eight-member Review Panel (75% community-based) deliberated and discussed the ranked projects to make a funding recommendation to the County Executive's Office.

#### **Community-Informed Proposals**

Milwaukee County gathered local, statewide, and program specific input from community members, stakeholders and front-line staff in the development of the proposals. Recommendations were community-informed through:

- Department and program community engagement efforts
- Local and statewide reports
- Proposal content that details local data, community interest, and promising practices
- Community participation on Review Panel (75% community-based including two individuals with lived experience)


