- A. Approval of this resolution will provide a total of \$11,456,094 in Opioid Settlement Funds for 15 proposed projects for Fiscal Years 2023-2025. The projects will address the opioid crisis across Milwaukee County through treatment, harm reduction, prevention and other strategies.
- B. Approval of this resolution would allocate \$11,456,094 of Milwaukee's Opioid Settlement Award of \$56.6 million. The Office of the Comptroller projects that Milwaukee County will receive approximately \$19.1 M in Settlement funding through 2025 based on a disbursement schedule provided by advisors. If the approximately \$11.5 million of recommended projects are approved, \$7.6 million of opioid settlement funding is estimated to remain available for future allocations in the years 2023 to 2025.

- C. Approved County Board Resolution 21-1127 called for the establishment of a segregated Opioid Abatement Account that is not part of the general fund. Costs for these 15 projects are anticipated to be incurred effective February 4, 2023 through December 31, 2025. Any unused funds that remain at the end of the year will be carried over to the new year.
- D. No assumptions or interpretations were made when preparing this fiscal note. The County has been provided a payment schedule by the settlement representative (attached). The Office of the Comptroller projects the County will receive up to \$19 million in payments through 2025.
