7 8 9 10 11 12	WHEREAS, the Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 was signed into law by President Biden on March 11, 2021, in efforts to support individuals, families, businesses, and governments impacted by the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic; and
13 14	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) will receive \$183.7 million in ARPA funding, through the ARPA State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund; and
15 16 17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) adopted File No. 21-555: "A resolution to create a Task Force (ARPA Task Force) to review and recommend funding allocations to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for monies received by the County in the Federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021"; and
21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, of the County's \$183.7 million of ARPA aid, \$5.5 million, has been recommended by the ARPA Task Force for COVID-19 mitigation to fund COVID-19 mitigation efforts; and
25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, in December 2022, the COVID-19 mitigation subgroup recommended the authorization of \$2 million in ARPA Funds for County COVID-19 mitigation strategies within the COVID-19 mitigation category; and
29 30 31 32	WHEREAS, since December 2022, the subgroup has reviewed 24 requests for COVID-19 mitigation funds, and approved \$2,157,045 in expenses of the \$2.5 million COVID-19 mitigation allocated and approved by the County Board; and
33 34 35 36	WHEREAS, the COVID-19 mitigation funds are requested by department and office leads to purchase personal protective equipment, testing, physical changes to facilities, and other mitigation efforts; and
37 38 39 40 41	WHEREAS, focusing on internal COVID-19 mitigation improves the County's ability to proactively prepare the County to continue providing services throughout the ongoing pandemic, and to stabilize staff needed for pandemic responses in County service areas; and
42 43 44 45 46	WHEREAS, \$2 million in ARPA funding will ensure that there is continuity of funding for COVID-19 response activities when the allocation of \$2.5 million is fully expended; and

- WHEREAS, the ARPA Task Force recommended \$2 million to reduce the 47 ongoing risk of COVID-19 to employees and the people served in County facilities on 48 December 1, 2022 (vote 6-0); and 49 50
- WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of January 26, 2023. 51 recommended adoption of File No. 23-227 (vote 7-0); now, therefore, 52
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BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) 54 authorizes Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) mitigation efforts supported by American 55 Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) revenue in the amount of \$2 million to the appropriate 56 57 departments; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes the Office of 59 Strategy, Budget, and Performance (OSBP), and the Office of the Comptroller 60 (Comptroller) to process an administrative appropriation transfer of \$2 million to direct 61 funds to the appropriate departmental accounts for the COVID-19 mitigation efforts, 62 63 starting January 1, 2023, until December 31, 2024; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board authorizes the administrating 65 66 department, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), the Office of Corporation Counsel, Risk Management Division, DAS, Office of Economic Inclusion, DAS, 67 Comptroller, OSBP, and County Executive, to prepare, review, approve, and execute all 68 contracts and other documents, and take all actions as required for the purpose of 69 administering the above-referenced programs funded by the ARPA grant allocation 70 71 framework. 72

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
