15 16 17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, since 2018, the Children, Youth, and Family Services Division (CYFS)-DHHS, operated the Bakari Residential Care Center (RCC) through a contract with WCS, and in partnership with Behavioral Health Services Wraparound Milwaukee; and
21 22	WHEREAS, in 2022, the average daily population for kids enrolled in the program was generally less than seven youth; and
23 24 25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, due to the low enrollment and budgetary constraints, DHHS eliminated funding for this program in the 2023 Adopted Budget, and ended its provider contracts, including a Purchase of Service contract with WCS, as of December 31, 2022; and
29 30 31 32 33	WHEREAS, after CYFS-DHHS made the decision to no longer operate the program, WCS began planning to manage the Bakari RCC on its own, and recently received approval from the State of Wisconsin Department of Children and Families to operate the Bakari RCC as a Qualified Residential Treatment Program at a daily rate of \$702; and
34 35 36 37	WHEREAS, to maintain sufficient options for out-of-home care placements, and increase flexibility in procuring services only as needed, CYFS-DHHS is proposing to purchase beds on a fee-for-service basis with WCS; and
38 39 40	WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of January 26, 2023, recommended adoption of File No. 23-244 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,
