While I am currently no longer at MCW, I was there from July 1, 1989 through October 31, 2022 where I had the honor of working with every medical examiner during that time serving as the sole ocular pathology consultant for the office. Having worked closely with her since her arrival to the office in August 2006, I feel qualified to speak to her attributes for the position.

Dr. Tlomak is exceptionally well qualified for this role, having risen through the ranks and demonstrating great leadership skills. Shortly after her arrival, she became the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited Forensic Pathology fellowship program director, a role she still holds, and she always made sure to follow the program requirements while also making sure that the trainees received the required education.
