- A. Human Resources requests the abolishment of 1.0 FTE Human Resources Business Partner and the creation of 1.0 FTE Human Resources Generalist.
- B. Direct costs for the current year would be \$0 to the County. There is a \$23,512 decrease of moving 1.0 HR Business Partner to a HR Generalist. HR Business Partner and HR Generalist salaries are \$80,288 and \$56,776 respectively. There is no additional funding being requested to cover the cost of the new position create.

It is assumed that the created position would be hired with 19 pay periods remaining (April 3). Assuming a mid-range salary of \$56,776 (excluding fringe) hiring with 19 pay periods remaining would come at a cost of roughly \$41,490 for the remainder of 2023. In future years the decrease would be covered through the budget process.

- C. The impacts for 2023 are a decrease in personnel costs of \$23,512 annually. Assuming the position is hired at mid-range as pointed out above, with 19 pay periods remaining (April 3), the impact in 2023 is about \$41,490.
- D. Assumptions include: hired at \$56,776, not hired prior to April 3, 2023. In future years the cost decrease will be included in the annual budget process.
