Background/Position Duties:

This position is being created as a result of funding received from the opioid settlement as outlined in County Board File No. 23-114. These positions will allow the Medical Examiner's Office to adequately respond to and provide surveillance regarding opioid deaths in Milwaukee County.

<u>Fiscal Effect</u>: This position will be funded by opioid settlement funds. The Medical Examiner's Office will work in cooperation with the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance to identify tax levy sources to offset the cost of the positions as soon as feasible.
