- A. Approval of this resolution would authorize the creation of 2.0 FTE Treatment and Resource Navigators in paygrade 22.
- B. The Opioid Settlement funding of \$481,570 appropriated to Housing Services for its Homeless Outreach Project supports the salary, social security and active fringe benefit costs of both positions starting as of pay period 12 (May 29, 2023) to December 31, 2025.
- C. For 2023, the total annual cost would be \$74,201 assuming a salary at the higher range and social security for both positions as of pay period 12 in 2023. The ongoing annual salary and social security cost is \$128,615 for both positions. In addition, active fringe benefit costs associated with this position would also be reimbursed.
- D. The Homeless Outreach Project is authorized starting January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2025. It is assumed that these positions would be absorbed into the DHHS budget and offset by vacancies in the department or another funding source will be identified.
