46 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby amends 47 Sections 17.14 (10) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances, by adopting 48 the following: 49 50 AN ORDINANCE 51 52 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows: 53 54 **SECTION 1.** Section 17.14(10)(a) of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is 55 hereby amended as follows: 56 57 (10) Special Uniform Allowance 58 59 (a) Employes, who are required to wear uniforms, shall be allowed uniform allowances 60 as follows: 61 1. Deputy sheriff lieutenants, deputy sheriff captains, deputy sheriff deputy 62 inspector, deputy sheriff inspector, communications supervisor (sheriff's department), director/internal affairs, identification bureau supervisor, investigator 63 64 (exempt) and chief investigator (exempt) shall be paid an annual clothing allowance equal to the amount paid deputy sheriff I's and II's and deputy sheriff 65 66 sergeants. 67 2. Museum security officer III shall be provided the full initial issue of 68 required uniforms, plus an annual allowance equal to that of museum security officers I and II, to be paid on a monthly basis for each calendar 69 70 month in which they perform services requiring the wearing of a complete 71 uniform. 72 2. Correctional officers, correctional officer sergeants, correctional officer lieutenants, correction manager, public safety officers, and public safety 73 74 officer supervisors in the sheriff's department shall be paid an annual 75 clothing allowance. 3. Assistant superintendent, correctional officers, correctional officer 76 77 sergeants, correctional officer lieutenants, correction manager, and correction truck driver in the community reintegration center shall be paid 78 79 an annual clothing allowance. 80 3 4. The airport fire chief and assistant airport fire chief shall be furnished a full uniform at the time of hire or as soon thereafter as practicable if no uniform had 81 82 previously been issued. The uniform so furnished shall be in accordance with the 83 regulations of the department setting forth prescribed minimum equipment for each employe. Any employe whose employment is terminated within two (2) 84 vears from the date of hire shall return all uniform items furnished by the county 85 to the department within seven (7) days of termination. After completion of one 86 (1) year of service, after obtaining authorized uniform, an annual clothing 87 allowance equal to the amount paid firefighter and equipment operators and 88 89 firefighter and equipment operators in charge shall be paid.

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91	4 <u>5</u> . Custodial workers I and II at the airport <u>Airport maintenance worker</u>
92	assistants who are employed on a full-time basis and who are required to wear
93	a uniform shall be paid a uniform allowance as institutional employes after six (6)
94	months of service and at the completion of each year of service thereafter.
95	5 6. Institutional employes, medical interns, resident physicians, who are
96	employed on a full-time basis and who are required to wear a uniform, except
97	those who receive some type of uniform allowance under paragraph (a) hereof,
98	shall be paid a uniform allowance of one hundred ten dollars (\$110.00) after six
99	(6) months of service and at the completion of each year of service thereafter.
100	6. Cooks and bakers may have their uniforms laundered at an institutional
101	laundry without charge.
102	7. Any nonrepresented supervisory nursing or supervisory laboratory
103	employe, who is required to wear a uniform and who supervises employes
104	represented by the Federation of Nurses and Health Professionals shall
105	receive the same payment for uniform allowance as may be provided for in
106	the Federation of Nurses and Health Professionals collective bargaining
107	agreement.
108	8 7. Any represented employe required to wear a uniform may receive such
109	uniform and/or payment of uniform allowance as may be provided for by the
110	respective collective bargaining agreements.
111	8. Job classifications eligible for annual uniform allowance and the manner
112	in which uniform allowances are paid are clarified in the Uniform Allowance
113	Administrative Manual of Operating Procedure (AMOP).
114	9. Any employe required to carry firearms shall be furnished with such firearm by
115	the county, provided that this firearm shall remain the property of the county and
116	be returned when the employe leaves the county service or is no longer required
117	to carry such firearm.
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119	SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and
