  - A. Authorization to apply for an accept a RAISE grant is requested.
  - B. Should the County be awarded a RAISE grant for the purchase of 46 buses, the federal share is estimated at 80% to be \$33.6M and the local 20% required match is estimated to be \$8.4M. If the County receives a RAISE grant for transit system infrastructure improvements, the estimated 80% federal would be \$11.4M and the required local 20% match would be \$2.85M.
  - C. Funding for the local match would not be required for 2023. The Department will request the local match for the 2024 capital improvements budget or a subsequent capital improvements budget depending upon the timing of the grant awards.
