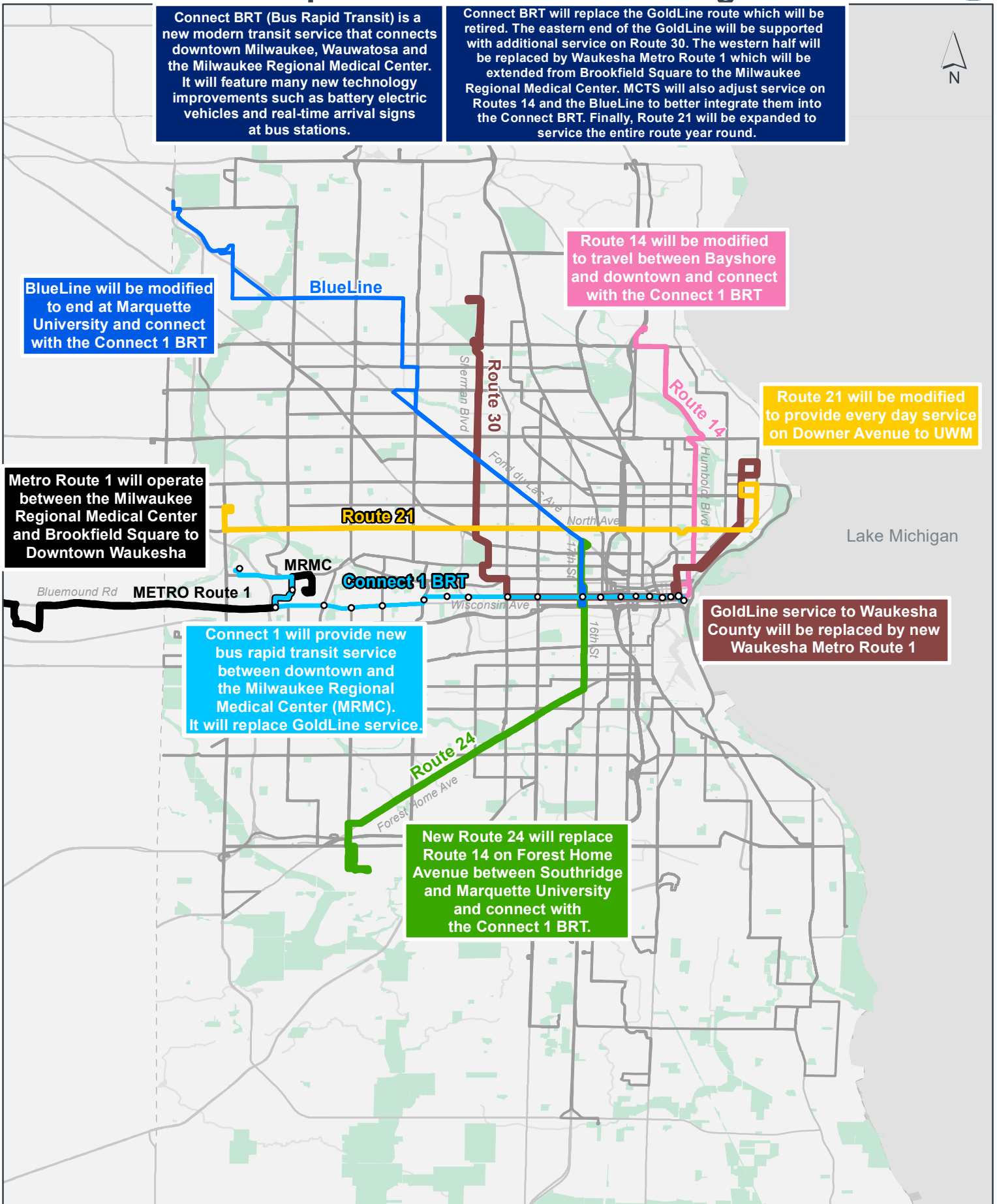


2023 Connect 1 BRT & Proposed Local Route Changes



Connect BRT (Bus Rapid Transit) is a new modern transit service that connects downtown Milwaukee, Wauwatosa and the Milwaukee Regional Medical Center. It will feature many new technology improvements such as battery electric vehicles and real-time arrival signs at bus stations.

Connect BRT will replace the GoldLine route which will be retired. The eastern end of the GoldLine will be supported with additional service on Route 30. The western half will be replaced by Waukesha Metro Route 1 which will be extended from Brookfield Square to the Milwaukee Regional Medical Center. MCTS will also adjust service on Routes 14 and the BlueLine to better integrate them into the Connect BRT. Finally, Route 21 will be expanded to service the entire route year round.
