COVID-19 Policy

With respect for the safety and well-being of our members, attendees and the communities they serve, as well as our own work to promote vaccines as a part of healthy aging, USAging requires proof of vaccination against COVID-19 to participate in our in-person events.

This means:

- Proof of being fully vaccinated (per the CDC definition) will be required. Have a digital or paper copy of your proof of vaccination ready when you arrive at the conference.
- For those with an exemption from vaccination, we offer an alternative option for you to attend the event: we require you to provide, upon arrival at the event, proof of a negative COVID-19 test result taken no more than 48 hours prior to arrival.

We also strongly encourage all attendees:

- be fully up to date with the latest COVID-19 booster for which they are eligible; and
- to take a COVID-19 test before traveling to the event.
