21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, of the County's \$183.7 million of ARPA aid, approximately \$129,933,003, has been recommended by the ARPA Task Force for Revenue Loss Recovery, to provide government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue experienced due to the pandemic; and
25 26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, in March of 2023, the Revenue Loss Recovery Subgroup recommended the Procurement Division (Procurement), Department of Administrative Services (DAS), receive \$263,644 in Revenue Loss Recovery funding, based on criteria set forth by the ARPA Task Force; and
