17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, in March 2021, President Biden signed into the law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), which provided states with over \$1.4 billion in OAA funding to allocate to local area agencies on aging; and
21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, through its ARPA allocation, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services has allocated \$2,051,427 in OAA funding, with a required match of \$300,512, to the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS); and
25 26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, DHHS has received approval for the match amount of \$300,512, in accordance with Adopted File No. 22-905, which authorizes a Matching Grant Pilot Program supported by a portion of Milwaukee County's (the County) \$183.7 million ARPA allocation; and
30 31 32 33	WHEREAS, DHHS staff will work collaboratively with the Commission on Aging and older adults in the County, to determine the best use of OAA dollars provided through the ARPA legislation; and
34 35 36	WHEREAS, DHHS staff and the Commission on Aging will utilize its 2022-2024 Area Aging Plan as the guide for the best use of ARPA/OAA dollars; and
37 38 39 40 41	WHEREAS, per Section 53.09, Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances, any contract recommendations from the Commission on Aging that utilize ARPA/OAA funding will be submitted to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for review and approval; and
42 43 44 45 46	WHEREAS, the Committee on Health Equity, Human Needs, and Strategic Planning, at its meeting of April 6, 2023, considered File No. 23-421 for informational purposes only; and
