- A. The resolution would approve the creation of 1.0 FTE Dementia Care Specialist in paygrade 29M and abolishment of 1.0 FTE ADRC Professional in pay grade 16Z4 within Aging and Disability Services.
- B. For 2023, the total 2023 salary and social security cost for the creation of the Dementia Care Specialist is \$32,673. This assumes this position is hired at the minimum salary point in the pay range and filled by pay period 15 (July 10, 2023). The full annualized cost for salary and social security is estimated to be \$70,477 in 2024. Approximately, 48 percent of these costs are covered by Medical Assistance match funding generated by the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC).
- C. This cost is offset by the abolishment of the ADRC Professional position. This provides a savings in salary and fringe of \$31,653 in 2023 and \$68,276 annually. The net increase in costs from the creation of the Dementia Care Specialist and the abolishment of the ADRC Professional is \$1,020 in 2023. This cost will be covered by vacancies within the department. Adjustments will be made to the 2024 Budget to manage the additional cost of \$2,201.
- D. The accompanying resolution authorizes the creates as of pay period 12, effective May 29, 2023 to ensure timely recruitment. However, this fiscal note calculates the total cost as of pay period 15 (July 10, 2023) which is anticipated to be the most realistic timeframe for actually filling the position and incurring costs.
