Public Input Meetings

Overwhelming support for:

- Renaming the park to honor the \$2.5MM gift from the George F.
 Moss Charitable Trust.
- Park features including fitness elements, family challenge course and interactive playground features
- Adaptive sports including baseball, pickleball and basketball
- A "nature" themed play area with music, climbing elements and features that spark imagination.



Public Input via Survey

100+ surveys filled out by residents

- Overwhelming support and excitement for features being added to the park (average score: 4.47/5 across seven unique features.)
- Most requested additional features:
 - Mini golf / putting green
 - Scoreboards that convert into movie screens
 - Beer garden
