Background

The Milwaukee County Board approved Resolutions 21-1127 and 23-490 which authorized Milwaukee County Office of Corporation Counsel (OCC) to enter into Settlement Agreements to receive funds from two separate lawsuits:

- Milwaukee County will receive \$102 million over 18 years.
- Any unused funds that remain at the end of the year will be carried over to the new year.

Request for Additional Funds

In December 2022, the County Board approved \$11 million in funding allocations for 15 projects from four County departments.

The award of a second settlement in 2023 provided Milwaukee County with a one-time opportunity to provide additional funds to currently funded projects.
