WHEREAS, September 15th to October 15th is National Hispanic Heritage Month,

WHEREAS, many Latin American countries celebrate their independence during September and October, including Mexico, Guatemala, Honduras, Chile, El Salvador, Nicaragua, and Costa Rica, all of which include immigrants within the United States and Milwaukee County; and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County strives to promote a responsive and inclusive community, as such, the word "Latine" is being used as a synonym to "Latinx", providing a gender-neutral and inclusive alternative to the term "Latino/a"; and

WHEREAS, approximately 16.4% of Milwaukee County's residents identify as Latine, representing a significant source of culture and diversity within the County; and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County recognizes various months of the year as a special month including flags and cultural events, providing an opportunity for the Latine community to be recognized and included; and

WHEREAS, Latine residents contribute to Milwaukee County's local economy, working in various jobs and attending schools to better the County's present and future; and

WHEREAS, as the result of decades of systemic racism, barriers, and inequality, Milwaukee County's Latine community faces disproportionate opportunities in employment and education; and
