14 15 16 17 18 19	WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) has had a successful experience utilizing TAP grants to address the popular Oak Leaf Trail (OLT) system, one of the most popular transportation alternatives to vehicular travel in our region; and
20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, DPRC owns two OLT bridges near the eastern end of Lincoln Park that span across Highway Interstate 43 and West Port Washington Road north of Hampton Avenue; and
