9 10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, the City of Wauwatosa (the City) is requesting an easement across parkland near 115 th Street and Underwood Creek across the Oak Leaf Trail (OLT) for a storm sewer to alleviate flooding impacts for the community; and
13 14 15 16	WHEREAS, there is currently a storm sewer pipe at this location that is owned by the City, but it is undersized and does not have an easement; and
10 17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, to effectuate the construction of the improvements, the City requires a Permanent Easement (the Easement) of 13,154 square feet for installation and future maintenance, repair, and replacement purposes of the storm sewer pipe; and
21 22 23	WHEREAS, the City is offering to rehabilitate the OLT from 115 th Street to the desired easement location, including addressing the flooding and failure on the OLT; and
24 25 26 27 28 20	WHEREAS, additionally, the City will improve the connection at 115 th Street to include a new crossing to connect to a future bicycle and pedestrian trail, as well as provide increased connectivity by making improvements west up to the Milwaukee County trail improvements that end at 119 th Street; and
29 30 31	WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC), retains the right to require a right-of-entry permit for all work on parkland; and
32 33 34 35	WHEREAS, it is the City's role and responsibility to identify, propose, and pay for the project, as well as all required future maintenance and repairs; and
36 37 38 39	WHEREAS, based on the size of the Easement, the minimal impact to parkland and natural areas, the overall benefit to the community, the need for a recorded Easement, and the improvements to the OLT, including flood mitigation, DPRC is recommending approval of this Easement; and
40 41 42 43 44	WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks and Culture, at its meeting of September 12, 2023, recommended adoption of File No. 23-793 (vote 4-0); now, therefore,

45 BE IT RESOLVED, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture, is hereby 46 authorized to prepare, review, approve, execute, record, and/or implement the required 47 documents or perform actions required to grant the Permanent Infrastructure Easement 48 (the Easement) to the City of Wauwatosa (the City) for the construction, operation, and 49 maintenance of the City's storm sewer by 115th Street and Underwood Creek across the 50 Oak Leaf Trail; and 51 52

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Executive and County Clerk are 53 authorized to execute any required documents to effectuate the approved permanent 54 storm sewer Easement. 55

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
