

From the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, certifying the property tax levy required in partial support of regional planning in Southeastern Wisconsin in Calendar Year 2024, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 66.0309(14)(b), Wisconsin State Statutes, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC) has submitted its budget for aid for the calendar year 2024 in the amount of \$2,370,245 and the allocation of said amount to each of the seven counties in the SEWRPC area on the basis of the equalized value of each county as of January 1, 2022, to the total equalized value of the seven counties as of January 1, 2022, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance-Budget, at its meeting of October 12, 2023, recommended adoption of File No. 23-734 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, there is hereby levied upon all taxable property within Milwaukee County (the County) \$780,710 as the County's proper portion of the 2024 budget of the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC), said amount to be transmitted to the Treasurer, SEWRPC, after January 1, 2024, upon demand of said Treasurer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the proper County officers are directed to distribute to each municipality within the County, its share of the above \$780,710 based on the ratio of each municipality's equalized value to the total equalized value of the County.
