**County Ordinance No. 23-6

AN ORDINANCE

The Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1.01(d) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

1.01. – Meetings.

- (a) *Annual meeting.* The statutory or annual meeting of the county board shall be convened on the first or second Thursday in November, consistent with Wis. Stat. § 59.11(1)(a), for the purpose of considering reports of the committee on finance on new positions for the next fiscal year as well as recommendations for amendments to the executive's budget.
- (b) *[Regular meetings.]* Regular meetings of the county board shall convene at 9:30 a.m. unless otherwise designated. In order to provide an advanced schedule of regular meeting dates, a regular meeting of the county board shall be scheduled generally on a Thursday within each month, except when otherwise designated by the county board meeting schedule, these rules or by action of the county board. August and November will not have a regularly scheduled meeting of the county board, unless otherwise called for by the county board. The county board chairperson shall provide to the county board, following the first meeting of the board after the election of supervisors, a schedule of county board meetings for the remainder of the term, including the date of the annual meeting provided in § 1.01(a). The first (organizational) meeting of the term shall be held on the third Monday in April of even-numbered years, which is the first day supervisors take office following their election per § 59.10(2)(b), Wis. Stats. The digest (agenda) for each county board meeting shall be established by the county board chairperson or, in his or her absence, by the first vice chairperson or the second vice chairperson.
- (c) *Special meetings.* A special meeting shall be held only when requested by a majority of the members of the county board, such request to be in writing, addressed and delivered to the county clerk, who shall note the time of such delivery to him/her on such request. Such request shall specify the time and place of such meeting, which shall not be less than forty-eight (48) hours after the delivery of such notice to the county clerk. The request shall identify the purpose of such meeting and shall include reference to such other items as may be required by law, ordinance or board action. Upon receiving such request, the county clerk shall forthwith give notice of the time and place of such meeting by

49 mail to each member of the county board. If the request is delivered to the county
50 clerk less than seventy-two (72) hours before the time of such meeting, the
51 county clerk, in addition to the mailing hereinbefore referred to, shall telephone
52 each supervisor; if any supervisor is not contacted by telephone, the county clerk
53 shall furnish to the sheriff of the county a copy of such notice of time and place of
54 meeting for delivery to unnoticed members of the county board. The sheriff shall
55 thereafter furnish to the county clerk an affidavit of delivery of such notice. The
56 inability of the sheriff to deliver such notice to a supervisor shall not be deemed a
57 defect to the notice requirement under this subsection. Any special meeting may
58 be adjourned from time to time by a vote of a majority of all members of the
59 county board.

61 (d) *Remote meetings.* The county board shall be equipped and may convene and
62 meet to conduct business remotely via telephone conference, video conference or
63 other electronic communication provided that the meeting is live-streamed, televised
64 live or otherwise broadcast live to the public, **subject to the following:**

66 **(1) Virtual-only county board meetings shall be reserved for an**
67 **emergency or other extraordinary circumstance.**

69 **SECTION 2.** Section 1.13(e) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is
70 hereby amended as follows:

72 (e) *Remote meetings.* Standing committees shall be equipped ~~and may convene~~
73 ~~and meet~~ to conduct business remotely via telephone conference, video conference
74 or other electronic communication provided that the meeting is live-streamed,
75 televised live or otherwise broadcast live to the public, subject to the following:

77 (1) If a committee chairperson chooses to schedule a committee meeting as a
78 hybrid meeting, the chairperson shall attend in-person at the courthouse
79 or at the physical location of the designated meeting. In exigent
80 circumstances, the vice-chairperson of the committee may fulfill this
81 requirement if the chairperson is not able to attend in person.
82

83 **(2) Virtual-only county board meetings shall be reserved for an**
84 **emergency or other extraordinary circumstance.**

86 **(23) Supervisors not subject to 1.13(e)(1), staff, and M** members of the
87 public wishing to testify shall have the option to attend any standing meeting
88 remotely, other than Committee of the Whole, via the electronic
89 communication protocol designated for the meeting.

91 **SECTION 3.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage
92 and publication.
