- A. If approved, this resolution would fund complete architectural, civil engineer and traffic engineer services to redesign the east vehicular entry/egress, traffic pattern and new ticketing facilities at the Milwaukee County Zoo as part of Capital Project WZ017401. According to the Department, the project will 1) generate incremental revenue on an annual basis through a variety of activities; 2) improve the safety of guests coming to the Zoo; 3) significantly enhance the customer experience and reduce complaints; and 4) provide some annual cost savings. The project must be designed to be constructed in phases to maintain Zoo operations and address pedestrian access, parking, emergency services, and gatherings.
- **B.** This resolution directs the Office of the Comptroller and the Department of Administrative services to process an administrative transfer to fund a capital project to reconfigure the Zoo's front entrance and admissions (WZ017401). If approved, this project would be paid for utilizing unexpended funds from Agency 194-1945 Appropriation for Contingencies budget.
- C. This resolution authorizes an administrative transfer of \$1,737,050 from Agency 194-1945 Appropriation for Contingencies to Capital Project WZ017401- Zoo Front Entrance Admissions reconfiguration. To the extent that funds from the Appropriation for Contingencies are expended, it either reduces the County's year-end surplus or increases its deficit. When this project was reviewed by the Capital Improvements Committee, the estimated future construction costs were approximately \$12,891,160.
- **D.** No assumptions or interpretations were made.
