Report from the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, requesting approval to allocate anticipated 2024 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME funding, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, as part of the Annual Plan (the Plan) process, a hybrid public hearing was held with the Committee on Community, Environment, and Economic Development (CEED) on September 11, 2023; and

WHEREAS, for 2024, a review process was put in place by staff to objectively rank Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) projects based on a scoring system to make final recommendations, and a panel was arranged to score each competitive project based on this system; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Milwaukee County (the County) CDBG allocation totals approximately \$1,745,160; and

WHEREAS, 20 percent of the total funds can be used for administration; and

WHEREAS, 15 percent of the total funds can be set aside for public service projects; and

WHEREAS, the allocation continues to be split between large competitive projects and municipal projects; and

WHEREAS, although the municipal projects were not scored and ranked for the purposes of this report, they are included to show the complete allocation; and

WHEREAS, projects must serve low-to-moderate income individuals within the County CDBG jurisdiction, otherwise the County cannot fund these projects per the United States (U.S.) Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) regulations; and

WHEREAS, the HOME Program (the Program) was born out of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, and was a spin-off of the CDBG Program; and

WHEREAS, the County, as a designated Urban County, is part of a HOME Consortium with the Cities of West Allis and Wauwatosa; and

WHEREAS, approval by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) of the recommendations for the 2023 HOME funding, anticipated to be \$1,422,083 (includes prior year Program income), is required to complete the 2024 Plan, which is submitted to the U.S. HUD; and

WHEREAS, all recommended CDBG and HOME projects fit the priorities and objectives of the five-year County Consolidated Plan; and

WHEREAS, all County CDBG and HOME funds must be spent outside the City of Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, pending County Board approval, the 2024 Plan will be published for a required 30-day comment period, and any public comments will then be incorporated into the final 2024 Plan and submitted to the U.S. HUD for approval; and

WHEREAS, originally approved through adopted File No. 23-243, the scope of work for the Greenfield Playground Improvements has changed from the original request to the construction of a nature shelter; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brown Deer was unable to complete two prior year projects due to the Coronavirus Disease and other delays, and funds will be reallocated to complete both projects in 2024; and

WHEREAS, CEED, at its meeting of December 11, 2023, recommended adoption of File No. 23-964 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, in no case will program expenditures exceed available revenue, and projects will be adjusted on a percentage basis if the final award from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development differs from Milwaukee County's funding amounts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, or her designee, to allocate the total anticipated 2024 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME funds to the following projects:
