1 By Supervisors Rolland, Taylor (17), File No. 23-989 2 Johnson, Jr., and Logsdon 3 4 5 A RESOLUTION 6 7 To allocate \$1,737,050 from Agency 194-1945 – Appropriation for Contingencies to 8 Capital Project WZ017401 Zoo Front Entrance – Admissions Reconfiguration planning 9 and design 10 11 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Zoo is a beloved attraction for more than one 12 million annual visitors; and 13 14 WHEREAS, in 2023, the top-ranked capital improvement project submitted by 15 zoo leadership to the Capital Improvements Committee was WZ017401 Zoo Front 16 Entrance – Admissions Reconfiguration; and 17 18 WHEREAS, a reconfiguration of the zoo entrance could resolve a clear and 19 present traffic safety issue for zoo guests and motorists on Bluemound Road and also 20 capture new revenue that was previously lost; and 21 22 WHEREAS, as part of the Finance Committee meeting on October 12, 2023, the 23 Zoo Executive Director stated, "We believe that the way our current setup is for getting 24 guests into the zoo pushes the line out into the community and down on to the 25 highways, because our ticketing is at the beginning of our parking area. We have about 26 3,900 to 4,200 parking spots in front of the zoo, and if I could get the traffic to flow into 27 the zoo, fill the parking spots, and then pay to get into the zoo after they get out of their 28 vehicles and come into the facility, it would reduce the pressure on Bluemound"; and 29 30 WHEREAS, the Zoo Executive Director also emphasized that, "As cars peel out 31 of the line because they don't want to wait, we are losing opportunities to generate 32 revenue. That can be significant"; and 33 34 WHEREAS, on August 17, 2023, the Milwaukee County Capital Improvements Committee included WZ017401 Zoo Front Entrance – Admissions Reconfiguration as 35 36 part of its recommendation for 2024 capital improvements, but the item was not 37 included as part of the County Executive's 2024 Recommended Capital Budget; and 38 39 WHEREAS, during the Milwaukee County Committee on Finance meeting held

on September 14, 2023, Office of the Comptroller Financial Services Director shared

the 2023 Fiscal Projection for Milwaukee County as part of File No. 23-69 noting that,

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"Based on financial results through the most recent reporting period, prior monthly reports submitted by departments and known projected actions, Milwaukee County's projected 2023 year-end fiscal status is a surplus of \$35.7 million"; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 14, 2023, recommended adoption of File No. 23-989 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the Office of the Comptroller and the Department of Administrative Services to process an administrative transfer of \$1,737,050 from Agency 194-1945 Appropriation for Contingencies to Capital Project WZ017401 Zoo Front Entrance – Admissions Reconfiguration planning and design.
