FROM THE OFFICE OF GEORGE L. CHRISTENSON MILWAUKEE COUNTY CLERK County Ordinance No. 23-11 File No. 23-853 AN ORDINANCE

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 91.02 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is hereby amended as follows:

91.02 - Definitions.

The following words have the designated meanings in this chapter unless a different meaning is expressly provided or the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

(1) "Public safety answering point" (PSAP) means the location where 9-1-1 calls are answered. These locations shall be staffed twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week.

(2) "Automatic number identification" (ANI) means the automatic display of the telephone number of the calling party. This number is simultaneously displayed on the PSAP display equipment as the PSAP operator or dispatcher answers the call.

- (3) "Automatic location identification" (ALI) means the automatic display of the address location of the calling party. This information is simultaneously displayed on the PSAP display equipment as the PSAP operator or dispatcher answers the call.
- (4) "Selective routing" (SR) means the automatic routing of the 9-1-1 call to the appropriate primary PSAP serving the address of the telephone number from which the call is originated.

"Voice over internet protocol" (VoIP) means the technology that allows voice calls to be made using a broadband internet connection instead of a regular or analog phone line.

SECTION 2. Section 91.09 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is hereby amended as

allows:

91.09 - Mobile cellular phones.

Calls originating from mobile cellular phones networks within Milwaukee County shall be may be routed to Milwaukee County Office of Emergency Management-911 Division as the primary cellular. VoIP or landline public safety answering point or local jurisdictionif a signed agreement is in place with the municipality. If no agreement is in place, the calls will be routed directly to the serving municipality.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
