- A. The Director, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), is requesting approval to enter into a 2024 contract with the State of Wisconsin to operate the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) under the State's Family Care Program for the period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024.

Approval of this request will ensure the continued availability of reliable and objective information about the broad range of programs and services available to Milwaukee County residents with disabilities, ages 18 to 59, and older adults. This includes access to publicly funded long-term care programs including Family Care and IRIS.

- B. Approval of this request will enable DHHS Aging and Disabilities Services to accept \$7,088,650 in revenue.
- C. The 2024 ADRC contract totals \$7,088,650 which reflects an increase of \$1,599,065 over the 2023 contract and 2024 ADRC Budget. As part of the 2023-2025 Budget, the Wisconsin Legislature approved a permanent increase of \$7.5 million in statewide funding for ADRCs over the biennium. This increase, along with an updated allocation formula that considers health equity factors such as percentage of poverty, have resulted in an additional \$1,599,065 to Milwaukee County's ADRC. In the coming months, the ADRC will be developing a spending plan which will include requests for additional staff.
- D. No further assumptions are made.
